### **CAMP RULES**

Please be sure that you understand and are willing to comply with all of the camp rules:

1. Campers are expected to take part in all activities and field trips.
2. Campers are expected to report to all activities on time, to abide by the rules of conduct explained to them at the opening of camp and to conduct themselves in a manner which reflects well on themselves, their sponsors, the camp and on the public perception of hunters and anglers. Campers must pay full attention to all parts of the curriculum. Disruption such as inappropriate behavior and lack of cooperation will not be tolerated and will be cause for dismissal with no refund.
3. All medications must be properly labeled and must be given to the camp nurse upon arrival. Use of any unauthorized drugs or alcohol will be grounds for dismissal.
4. Campers may leave the camp area only if accompanied by an instructor.
5. No person may have firearms, hatchets, or knives of any type without permission of the Camp Director.
6. Walkman-type portable music devices are permitted for free time but must not appear at classes. Cell phones are not permitted.
7. Boats may be used only under counselor's supervision.
8. Swimming is permitted only at scheduled times.
9. Improper language will not be tolerated.
10. Smoking by campers is not permitted.
11. The camp cannot accommodate visitors as this removes the camper from scheduled activities and may aggravate homesickness.
12. Vandalism or destruction of camp property will be grounds for dismissal. Replacement costs will be borne by the camper.
13. Motor vehicles are not allowed at camp.

**Infractions of the above rules may result in camper's dismissal with no refund.**
