CAMP RULES

Please be sure that you understand and are willing to comply with all of the camp rules:

- 1. Campers are expected to take part in all activities and field trips.
- 2. Campers are expected to report to all activities on time, to abide by the rules of conduct explained to them at the opening of camp and to conduct themselves in a manner which reflects well on themselves, their sponsors, the Camp and on the public perception of hunters and anglers. Campers must pay full attention to all parts of the curriculum. Disruption such as inappropriate behavior and lack of cooperation will not be tolerated and may be cause for dismissal with no refund.
- 3. Improper language, fighting and bullying will not be tolerated and will be cause for dismissal with no refund. Bullying is unwanted, aggressive, repeated behavior through written or verbal expression or physical gesture or combination thereof.
- 4. Campers may leave the camp area only if accompanied by Camp Staff.
- 5. Electronic devices, including cell phones, are not permitted. Such items will be confiscated by staff if found, and returned after graduation.
- 6. Swimming is permitted only at scheduled times. 2 piece swim wear is not allowed for female campers. Moderate, 1 piece swim wear only!
- 7. No person may have firearms, hatchets, or knives of any type without permission of the Camp Director. Any such items found will be confiscated by staff and returned after graduation. Possession of these items may be cause for dismissal with no refund.
- 8. Tobacco in any form, including smokeless tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco, e-cigarettes and any related paraphernalia, is not permitted on camp property. Use or possession of any of these products will be grounds for dismissal with no refund. Use of any unauthorized drugs or alcohol will be grounds for dismissal with no refund.
- 9. All medications, including over the counter medications, must be properly labeled and must be given to the Health Supervisor upon arrival. Possession of any medications may be grounds for dismissal with no refund.
- 10. Vandalism or destruction of camp property may be grounds for dismissal with no refund. Replacement costs will be borne by the camper.
- 11. Boats may be used only under counselor's supervision.
- 12. Campers are not allowed to have motor vehicles at camp.
- 13. The camp cannot accommodate visitors as this removes the camper from scheduled activities and may aggravate homesickness.

Infractions of Camp Rules may result in camper's dismissal with no refund.
